*30 minutes – plan for approximately 1 hour to allow for check in time and to visit the pharmacy afterwards for your prescriptions

*\$30 no show fee for all patients that do not provide 24 hour notice to cancel appointment

*Bring all immunization records, list of medications, picture ID (UGA ID), and insurance card to your appointment

Charges: Office visit fee \$80 (complex, eg. 3 or more countries \$110) + vaccine charges and prescription charges.

Insurance: We file with insurance - please visit our webpage for more details and contact your insurance company to find out your coverage benefits at our Health Center.

Directions: Please visit our webpage for directions and map – we are tricky to find, not all GPS maps will bring you to our location. We are on the main floor of the Health Center near the pharmacy.
